DEVELOPING A REFERENTIAL TO ENHANCE MEDICAL PRACTICE

- ✓ Scoping review of existing referentials
- ✓ Co-creation with different types of general practices
- ✓ Validation by pairs
- ✓ Co-creation with patients by focus group



How to develop a university GP clinic and construct a network?

ESTABLISHING A HEALTH OBSERVATORY

- By using existing data as a foundation or starting point for further analysis, research, or development.
- To identify the health problems faced by GP assistants, to encourage diversity in their training pathways
- To create a practitioner-specific analysis of practice



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BUILDING TEACHING COMMUNITIES

- To create a network for practice
- To share experiential knowledge
- To promote knowledge co-creation
- To improve clinical practice, training, facilitate research, and enhance organizational performance
