

Erratum: Risk Stratification in Older Intensively Treated Patients With AML

The article by Versluis et al entitled “Risk Stratification in Older Intensively Treated Patients With AML” (*Journal of Clinical Oncology* [10.1200/JCO.23.02631](https://doi.org/10.1200/JCO.23.02631)) was published online September 4, 2024, with errors.

In the Results section, the scores for poor and very poor subgroups were incorrectly given. The sentence:

“Using quartiles of the score distribution, we collapsed patients of the development cohort into four groups defined as favorable (score 0–1 points; n = 170, 14.1%), intermediate (score 2–3; n = 485, 40.3%), poor (score 4–6; n = 339, 28.2%), and very poor (score 7–10; n = 210, 17.4%, Fig 3B)”,

should have been:

“Using quartiles of the score distribution, we collapsed patients of the development cohort into four groups defined as favorable (score 0–1 points; n = 170, 14.1%), intermediate (score 2–3; n = 485, 40.3%), poor (score 4–5; n = 339, 28.2%), and very poor (score 6–10; n = 210, 17.4%, Fig 3B)”.
